- Need to convince community



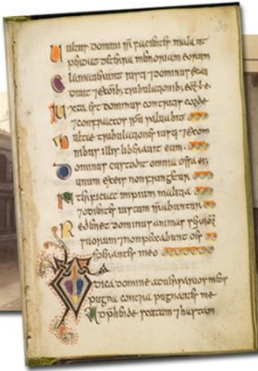

Next steps:

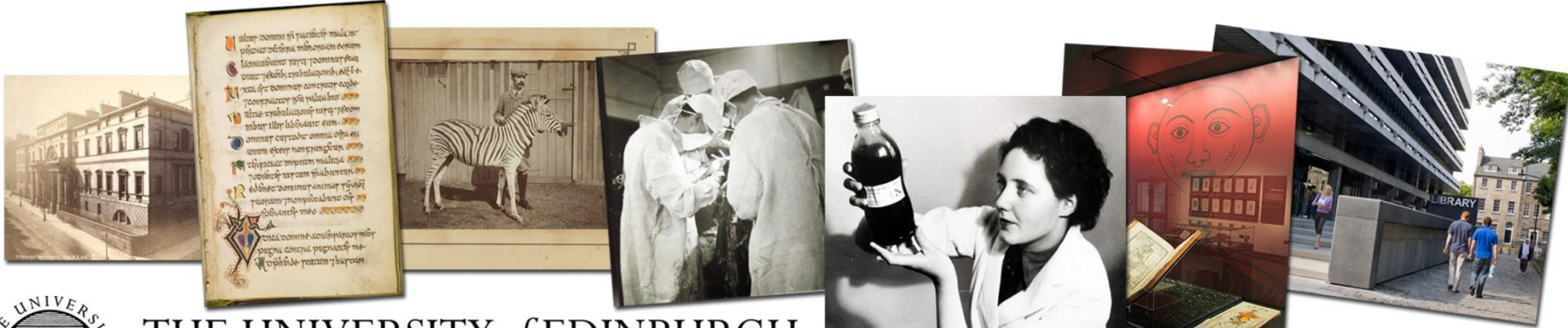
- An appropriate repository
