


## *Executive summary*

In order to systematically review library book collections in a quantitative and qualitative manner York is developing a “Collections Profile” tool. The intention is to inform future collection development and management decisions and to identify potential stock for withdrawal. Information produced through the Copac Collection Management tool in this pilot is used to supplement the local library management system (Aleph) reports. The subject area Language and Linguistic Science was used as a case study. The main objectives of this study were: to provide information on resources (within a local and national context), to increase content awareness, to improve the quality of collection development and to maximise cost effective use of shelf space.

(snapshot on 15th of month)**




